NATIONAL FAMILY CAREGIVER SUPPORT PROGRAM

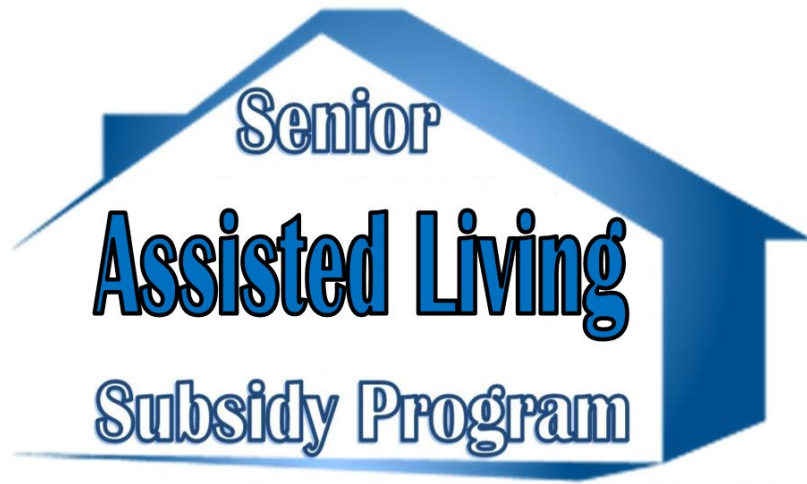
- Assist caregivers who are caring for a family member over 60 years old
- Grandparents raising grandchildren under 18

SENIOR CARE PROGRAM

- Assist older adults with remaining in the community
- 65 years +
- Provides – screening, assessment, case management and financial subsidies
- Ranking system utilized to ensure those with the highest level of need receive services





Access to Assisted Living for Qualifying Older Adults

- Funds subsidize payments to participating assisted living facilities
- 62+ years old
- Income requirements
- Annual redeterminations

VETERANS SHUTTLE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM

The Veteran's Shuttle provides service to specified Veterans Administration (VA) medical sites. There is no cost to the veteran or his/her personal care assistant for the Shuttle Program.

- Transportation is scheduled through and provided by CTS



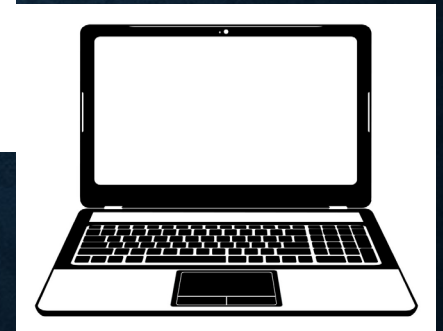
LONG TERM CARE OMBUDSMAN PROGRAM

- Protects privacy and confidentiality of residents
- Promotes quality of life and care
- Encourages self-advocacy
- Provides placement information
- Provides training on Residents' Rights, abuse, use of restraints
