Please review the list of acceptable materials before making a donation. Your donation keeps materials out of the landfill and helps communities rebuild.

- Tile (unused, not broken =>50sf)
- Doors (No interior hollow core doors)
- Lighting (with all parts, usable & in working condition)
- Floor covering (unused => 50 sf)
- Appliances (clean & less than 10 years old, must have cords)
- Hardware Insulation (unused wrapped or bagged)
- Cabinets (clean, not broken, has all doors & hardware
- Lumber (6' or longer)
- Marble tile (unused, not broken)
- Sinks (not broken or stained)

• Windows (whole windows, glass not broken)

No Paint or Used Carpeting

The following items CANNOT be accepted.

Explosive/combustible materials

Pathological/infectious or other medical wastes

Radioactive and other hazardous wastes

Electric arc furnace dust

"Free Liquids"

Sludges and similar residual wastes

Tree stumps

Logs & brush greater than 8" in diameter & 8' in length

Hot ashes or any material that shows evidence of smoking, smoldering, or burning

Concrete slabs/curbing, brick bats, stone or similar materials greater than 6" in dimension

Automobile parts, (complete bodies, frames, engine blocks & transmissions)

Sealed drums, closed large containers and tanks

Large slabs of iron, steel and other intact bulky wastes, which may be considered potentially detrimental to landfill equipment

pipe over 4' in length or 4" in diameter Dead animals

Out-of-County contractors, doing work within the County, may obtain a *continued* Temporary landfill permit upon request at the Northern Landfill.

The permits are restricted to 1 month or less; a vehicle registration card and information relevant to the job site is neccessary.

In addition to traditional household wastes generated in Carroll County,

Northern Landfill accepts:

Concrete/asphalt smaller than 6" in diameter - fee to dispose

Fluorescent bulbs & tubes (wrap in paper and place in plastic bag - fee to dispose

Latex paint cans - residue paint must hardened or dry - fee to dispose

Rotted railroad tie, wooden skids remodeling debris - fee to dispose

Tires - 5 per year/per household @ \$3.00/each (off rim), \$4.00/each (on rim), 33" limit (over 5 tires requires a State hauling license. Commercial Load, \$175/ton

White goods - scrap metals, washers, dryers, hot water heaters, air conditioners, freezers & refrigerators, (doors must be removed)- no charge

Yard trim - leaves, grass, shrubs, tree trimmings (limited to 8' in length & 8" in diameter) must be brought in paper lawn bags or loose. Plastic bags prohibited in this area. No charge to residents

SINGLE-STREAM RECYCLING

Items no longer need to be sorted; place the following togther in the designated drop-off area at the Recycling Center. Rinsed containers are preferred. No plastic bags, recycling must be loose.

Aluminum & bi-metal cans, aerosol cans, (empty only)

Plastic narrow neck containers & jugs #1 thru #7 only, (no motor oil or transmission fluid bottles), wide mouth plastic containers such as yogurt and cottage cheese. Lids and caps can stay on containers. (No #6 or #1 clamshell or fruit containers)

Food & beverage glass jars & bottles, all colors, not broken

Paper - newspaper, junk mail, magazines, catalogs, paperbacks, telephone books, flattened corrugated & light cardboard, paper bags, non-metalic wrapping paper, milk & juice containers, including gable top and aseptic containers. No shredded paper

NOTE: Used motor oil & antifreeze may be dropped off at the Town Maintenance Garages in Hampstead & Sykesville. Used motor oil may be dropped off at Westminster's Public Works Facility, Town of Manchester Garage & Taneytown Memorial Park

SORRY, WE CANNOT RECYCLE:

Wax coated paper, boxes, cardboard wtih plastic, wax or metal laminates

Pizza boxes

Papers contaminated by food, animal waste, grease or chemical residues

paper loads with total moisture content exceeding 12%

Heavily colored papers with water soluble inks

Items that once held petroleum products

Fluorescent tubes/bulbs
